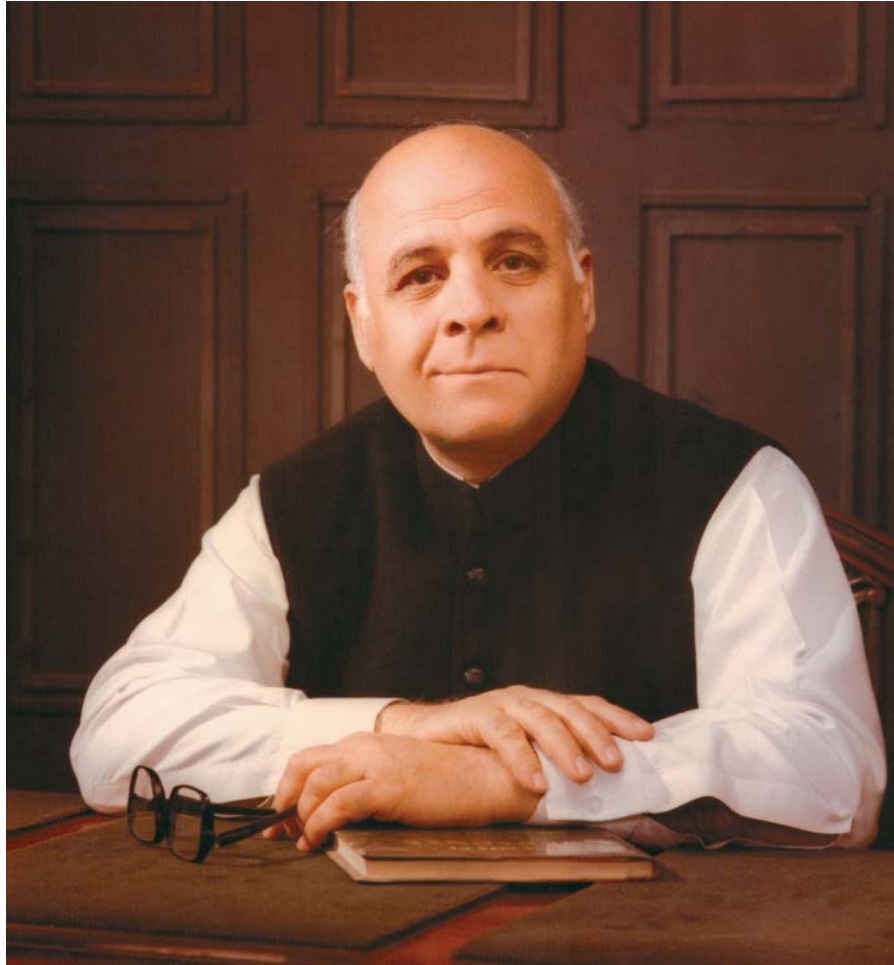

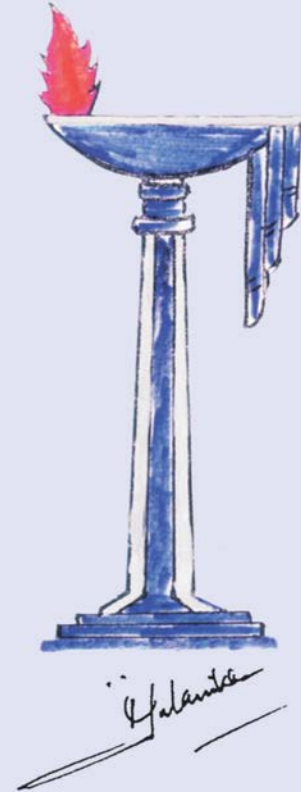

Chand Bagh College is next phase of his profound vision. In Chand Bagh College, the entire community of students, teachers and their families, staff, servants share their problems, anxieties, joys and sorrows. This develops an ethos wherein the Chand Bagh College becomes a living and pulsating extended family.

Residing and working together in an environment, which is their home and abode, the interaction between student, teacher and community, as a whole, helps in achievement of wider goals. Indeed friendliness and mutual trust is a salient feature of life at Chand Bagh College. The on-campus atmosphere and environment is stimulating, inspiring and conducive to creative activity, learning and inquiry. Facilities on Campus

The Chand Bagh College is set in a healthy rural environment some 40 km north of Lahore, off the Muridke - Sheikhupura Road accessible from either the Motorway or the Grand Trunk Road via Muridke. The Chand Bagh Campus' total area is about 450 acres. The Chand Bagh School's area is spread over 190 acres protected by a boundary wall. Adjacent to it, the Chand Bagh Foundation owns further 260 acres, which is reserved for the development of Chand Bagh College, which is already in progress.



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The Romanesque and spaciouly built buildings have been specially designed to reflect the aim and ethos of the School combining traditional features and modern techniques. The result is a much admired, elegant and award-winning complex alongside big sports grounds.

On the same model, the Chand Bagh College buildings will be constructed and functional shortly. In the meanwhile, the free space available in Chand Bagh School will be utilized.

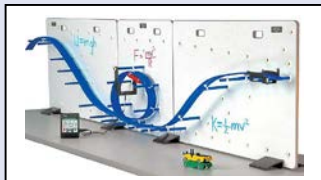
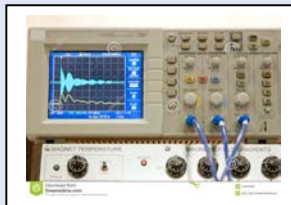
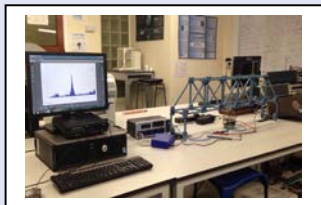

Science and Computer Laboratories

The Chand Bagh College has state-of-the-art laboratories for Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Virtual and Simulation Labs) with the latest technology and equipment at par with international standards.

The Chand Bagh College has a Computer Laboratory with the facility of more than one hundred latest technology computers along with its own networking and peripheral devices where students learn everything from the basics to the in-depth knowledge about computers with campus-wide Wi-Fi and Fiber optic connectivity for all the Students and Faculty Members.



Library

A well-furnished and purpose-built library caters for all requirements of the students and staff. The number of books is being steadily built up. The books are beautifully arranged, neatly kept and skillfully maintained in shelves. Newspapers and magazines are available for the students and the staff to read. The library is also used for self-study. There is a plan of adding 2000 more books within the next year. There are seven computers that are used for accessing Online Digital Library that has more than 25,000 books available and more are to be added in the near future.



Chand Bagh Health Centre

The Chand Bagh College has its own 10 bed Health Centre where two Medical Officers and four Dispensers remain available round the clock. Facilities for all types of emergency treatment are available in this Health Centre. Students' personal health problems are well-taken care of by the Resident Medical Officers who are highly trained and experienced. A ward with 10 beds is also available for the patients who need indoor medical care.



Masjid

There is a beautiful Masjid built in the premises so that student and staff can offer prayers five times a day. We believe that spiritual training of well-being is very important and everyone has the opportunity to offer prayers five times a day.



Administration

Sports & Physical Education

Besides playing friendly matches with other institutions, some of the leading foreign and Pakistani institutions are also invited to compete in these activities. Equestrian Club has been established for Horse Riding facility.

The program aims at preparing effective classroom teachers who:

- 1) Have mastery of content.
- 2) Can use modern instructional strategies to the needs of the learner.
- 3) Make optimum use of technology in instruction.
- 4) Perform all tasks related to effective instructions.
- 5) The goals will be attained through classroom teaching and learning, hands-on experiences and field base experiences in the form of teaching practice/practicum and supervised internship.

Entry Requirements: In order to get admission in this program, the applicant must have obtained a degree after 16 years of Education preferably in a school subject from an HEC recognized institution with minimum 2nd Division in annual system or CGPA 2 out of 4 in semester system. Teaching Practice

The duration of the teaching practice will be Four (4) weeks, which will be organized in the 2nd semester in the elementary level classes. A supervisor (UE faculty member) will be assigned to each student. The supervisor will observe at least two full lessons per week of each of his supervisor. A classroom observation form will be filled in for each visit. The class teacher in the school will play the role of a co-supervisor. The co-supervisor will be provided orientation regarding the purpose of the Teaching Practice and his responsibilities as an advising teacher. The role of the co-supervisor will be clearly defined and communicated. The co-supervisor will be required to remain present in the classroom for the whole time. The co-supervisor will write daily report on the prescribed form regarding the strengths, weaknesses and progress of the student. These reports will be submitted to the concerned supervisors for consideration while assessing the trainee teachers. The students will prepare a lesson plan for each class meeting, which shall be signed by the supervisor and the co-supervisor at least one day in advance. The final grade in the Teaching Practice will be based on the continuous evaluation of the supervisor and the co-supervisor and the evaluation of the external examiner, who will be appointed by the Controller of Examinations, University of Education. The external examiner will observe at least two lessons for the award of marks.

The distribution of the marks will be as follows:

- Supervisor 50%.
- Co-supervisor 20%.
- External Examiner 30%.
- Internship.

After the completion of the course work, there will be 3-months internship for all the B.Ed. students.
